- **TAG (Targeted Actions to Graduation)**: A specialized online program for 11th and 12th graders designed to provide smaller class sizes, a dedicated group of content teachers and a strong sense of community. Individualized on-campus sessions on Tuesdays. A quarter credit system allows students to work toward credit recovery and accelerated credit advancement. Families can apply online or students can be referred by their school counselor or administrator.
